16. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
17. See that your child does not bring crackers, colour etc. to the school. Bursting of crackers and playing with colours are liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
18. Try to inculcate good values in your children. Please do not encourage them to bring junk food in their lunch box.
19. Help us in making this school a polythene free zone. Ensure that your ward is not carrying any polythene bag.
20. It is mandatory for every student to enter the school premises on or before the given reporting time. Late comers will not be allowed to enter after the schedule time.

## SCHOOL RULES

1. Every student should carry his/her almanac and identity card to school each day.
2. **Monday Test must be written only in test copies, else their answers will not be evaluated and they will be awarded zero.**
3. Students are not allowed to go outside the class without class pass.
4. Students who come to school on their own should arrive at the school before the bell (five minutes before the home room period begins).
5. Changing of class rooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
6. Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The school uniform should be worn on all working days and for all school functions.
7. Non Sikh boys should get their proper hair cut at regular intervals. Girls with long hair should come in two plaits. **Colouring of hair is strictly prohibited for all the students.**
8. No shouting or whistling is allowed in or around the school building. Running in the corridors is strictly prohibited.
9. Care must be taken of all school properties and no student should scratch or spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture or write or draw on any belonging of others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the class teacher or to the representative.
10. The students are expected to report to the school authorities about any kind of damage to the school property by a particular child or a group. Those found guilty will be fined for the same.
11. No books (other than text books or library books), magazines or paper should be brought to school.
12. Lending or borrowing of money and other articles is not permitted.
13. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles to school. School will not be responsible for any articles lost. Students are advised not to wear gold ornaments to school.
14. Students not availing bus facilities should wait for their parents/guardians in the school premises when the school gets over. In case of delay, they should report to the school office. Those who go home alone, should not loiter about on their way but be prompt in returning straight to their home.
15. Students are supposed to board their buses from their respective bus stops.
16. Students should observe polite manners, wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their conduct. They should always greet the teachers when they meet them. Bullying and use of foul language are punishable offences.
17. The school reserves the right to dismiss a student whose diligence or progress in studies is steadily unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students. Misbehaviour or misconduct with any of the teaching or non-teaching staff shall call for strict action against the students.
18. Parents and guardians should not visit their wards or teachers in the class rooms without the permission of the Principal.

19. Unless an emergency arises students are not expected to seek permission to leave the school before the school gets over.
20. Students are not supposed to miss any teaching / games / activity period.
21. Bursting crackers or splashing colour during Diwali / Holi in the school premises is strictly forbidden. Non compliance with these instructions can result in expulsion from the school.
22. Name, class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all belongings including blazer and jersey of the students.
23. School appointees should wear their respective badges everyday.
24. Students should get their Report Cards signed by the guardians within two days of the receipt of the Report Card.
25. 75% and more attendance is compulsory for the students of XI and XII, 85% and more for the students of Prep to X.
26. No student is permitted to bring MOBILE PHONE / CAMERA to school.
27. POLYTHENE Bags are banned inside the campus.
28. Canteen facility is only for the students of XI and XII during the break time.

4. Select the payment category you wish to pay, viz. Annual Fee, Bi-Monthly Fee etc. If you select Annual Fee, page will open. Fill all details such as Student's Name, Admission No., Class, Section etc. Details marked with \* are mandatory. Fill all your details carefully. After filling all your requisite data, click on 'Submit Button'. Same process is also for Bi-Monthly Fee. Class wise '**Current fee structure**' will be displayed on school website.
5. Payment Confirmation page will open. Check all details, if all details are correct then click the 'Confirm Button'.
6. Payment Gateway page of SBI will open, select the mode of payment you want to use, e.g. Internet Banking/Debit Card/ ATM Card.
7. Select the payment mode and pay your fee. After Successful fee payment, fee receipt will be generated instantly. You can take the printout or save the same and update your fee card to show whenever required at the school.

### REPRINT PAYMENT RECEIPT

You can also 'Reprint' your receipt later for a successful transaction.

For Reprint of previous payment receipt, you have to:

1. Go to DPS website [www.dpsranchi.com](http://www.dpsranchi.com) and select '**Pay your fee using SBI Collect**'
2. The link will redirect you to State Bank Collect Portal.
3. Select the check box and click the 'proceed' button.
4. In the new open page, at the left upper side two options are available:
  - i) Reprint Remittance Form
  - ii) Payment History

You can regenerate your payment receipt after filling up the required details through both options.

2. Tuition Fee/Bus Fee are payable bi-monthly (two months) starting from April and it is to be paid for 12 months.
3. All dues should be cleared before the commencement of each examination or else he/she will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
4. Students appearing for the Board i.e. Class X & XII should clear their dues positively by January. No cheque will be accepted after the 'No dues' date.
5. Name of the student, who fails to deposit the fee even after fourth month, his/her name will be struck-off from the rolls of the school at the end of the fourth month. However such students can seek re-admission after clearing all the dues with an additional payment as a re-admission fee (Allowed only once in an academic session).
6. Any cheque returned by the bank will be treated under the category of non-payment of fee. In such cases, the fee will be accepted in demand draft only, with applicable fine at the school counter.
7. If a student wants to discontinue the bus service he/she must inform the office one month in advance and submit the bus pass in the office. No student will be allowed to discontinue the bus service from October onwards.
8. **Transfer Certificate** will be issued on a written request from the parents or guardian after settlement of all the dues of the school. One month's notice or one month's fees in lieu of notice period along with **Rs. 200.00 for T.C.** must be given in advance for the issue of Transfer Certificate.
9. Caution money is refundable in full only in the event of leaving the school and after adjustment of all dues. It should be claimed within six months from the date of issue of T.C., otherwise the claim for the same will not be entertained.

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## SCHOOL TRANSPORT

Students can avail the school transport subject to the availability of seats. The routes and stops of the school buses have been prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all students.

The school will not entertain any request for changes of bus-stops and bus-routes to suit an individual's convenience.

Parents should consult the school transport in-charge for necessary details regarding bus-stops and bus routes. Bus fee will be charged for twelve months in an academic year. The charges per pupil per month is given in the fee schedule available in the school office.

### BUS RULES

1. Students using the school bus must be at their bus stop at least five minutes prior to the arrival time of the bus. Buses will not wait for the latecomers. It is mandatory for all students availing bus to carry their bus ID card with them.
2. Students should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives and should not rush towards the entry door of the bus till it has come to a complete halt.
3. All students must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding their buses.
4. Drivers are authorized to stop buses only at the designated stops, unless directed otherwise by the bus in-charge.
5. No student should move around or put any part of his/her body out of the bus.
6. Food items or trash must not be discarded inside the bus or thrown out of the bus. Students are not allowed to eat in the bus.
7. Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused by negligence or vandalism. **Courteous behaviour is expected from students at all times and unruly behaviour is strictly prohibited. Students who resort to vandalism will be debarred from bus facility.**
8. Bus teachers are responsible for maintaining discipline inside the bus. Serious offences inside the bus should be reported to the Principal immediately.

## ADMISSION

Pupils are usually admitted in the school only at the beginning of the session i.e. in the month of April.

A student who has previously attended a recognized school, cannot be allowed admission in this school without a school leaving certificate from the institution last attended.

### ABSENCE

1. Students are responsible for making up all work missed by them.
2. No students will be allowed to step out of the school gate without the gate pass either signed by the class teacher or class representative.
3. No student who had been absent on the previous day, will be allowed to the class without the permission of the class teacher.
4. No leave of absence is granted except on medical grounds.
5. Repeated absence without any prior information or valid reason for more than six consecutive days renders the students off the rolls, re-admission may be granted only on payment of fresh admission fee.
6. Attendance is compulsory on the last working day and the reopening day of each vacation. Absence for more than three days immediately after a vacation renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls.
7. It is compulsory for the students to obtain 75% attendance in the academic year to make them eligible to sit for their final examination. The percentage however can be relaxed on medical grounds.
8. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a medical certificate permitting him to do so.

Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.

Promotion will be granted on securing minimum 40% and above in each subject.

It encompasses the achievements in academics and development at social, ethical and behavioural front.

## WITHDRAWALS

1. A calendar month's notice in writing must be submitted or a month's fee in lieu of such notice must be deposited to the school office before a pupil is withdrawn.



2. Transfer Certificate or withdrawals are not issued until all dues of the school are settled.
3. Students can be asked to leave the school on disciplinary grounds.

## SCHOOL LIBRARY

Library occupies a very prominent place in the educational set-up. Library is the treasure vault of ideas, the storehouse of knowledge and the flowing streams of living thought.

The school has 3 full fledged libraries, which are store houses of a large number of books on every subject for the use of the students. It is open to all bonafide students of the school. Each class is provided with at least one library period per week.

### The following rules to be observed by the students :

- Students must carry a library card duly signed by the librarian. Books are issued only against this card. Students of class III–XII are issued one card each, and they can issue only one book at a time against their library cards.
- Students are allowed to borrow against their own cards only.
- Students must maintain absolute silence in the library.
- Library books, other than reference books, are issued for 7/15 days. ₹ 2/- per day is charged for returning the book late.
- Books, if disfigured, damaged or lost will have to be replaced or paid for by the borrower or double fine will be charged as per the market price of the book.
- If the pages of the book are torn off (According to the condition of the book) ₹ 25/- to ₹ 50/- (Binding charge) will have to be paid by the borrower.
- The library has an open shelf system and students must help to maintain order and organisation in the different shelves. They must put the books on the tables after consultation and not just anywhere on the shelves.
- Students are not allowed to bring their personal books or belongings in the library.
- PENS and PENCILS are not allowed to be carried inside the library.

## HUMAN LIBRARY

### (The Living Books)

## HOUSE SYSTEM

4. In each group activity there should be one participant from each house.
